DIE LINE FILE REQUIREMENTS:

Color Craft uses ESKO ArtiosCAD software to create die-lines. Prototypes are created and provided to customer for review/approval. Upon signed approval, die lines are provided when requested.

Usable die file formats are; .ARD, .DXF, .DWG, AI.PDF's are acceptable if 100% and fully editable. Please contact Color Craft before sending any other format.

** Please request CCGA Die-line PRIOR to beginning your package artwork. **

PRE-PRESS ACCEPTED APPLICATIONS:

Color Craft prefers files that have been prepared on a Macintosh. If this is not possible, please talk to your customer service rep about the special requirements for files created on a PC.

The following Macintosh applications and versions are acceptable for submission:

ADOBE ILLUSTRATOR CC - LEGACY

Illustrator is the preferred application when producing files for packaging. All fonts to outlines and unused colors deleted is appreciated. ****All placed images should be 300dpi and placed at 100%**.

ADOBE PHOTOSHOP CC - LEGACY

Photoshop files will be accepted in TIFF, EPS, and Photoshop native formats. Files **MUST** be saved as **CMYK** and be at least 300 dpi in resolution at 100% to ensure quality output. Layered files appreciated if we are to edit.

ADOBE InDesign CC - LEGACY

All fonts to outlines and unused colors deleted is appreciated. **All placed images should be 300dpi and placed at 100%.

MICROSOFT WORD

We strongly advise against using Word for page layout. PDFs may work...no guarantees.

ADOBE ACROBAT PDF

Hi-res PDF files for final output are acceptable providing files follow CCGA specifications. CCGA Die must be utilized. **Die-line MUST overprint**. Please inform us if supplied files are trapped.

If your program is not listed here, please contact CCGA customer service to review any application compatibility considerations.
